

Terms and Conditions First Aid Kit Fundraiser

Definitions

In this instance the school or community group participating in the St John fundraising program will be referred to as 'The Organiser'.

The 'Fundraising Period' refers to the period of time in which The Organiser will be running the fundraising initiative. This is the time that they are collecting order to the time that order forms are returned to St John.

'Products' in this instance refer to the selection of first aid kits offered as part of St John's fundraising program.

General Terms

1. Products ordered as part of the fundraising initiative must be placed with The Organiser during the agreed Fundraising Period. Failure to do so will result in any late or additional orders being treated as separate purchases and will not contribute to The Organiser's fundraising initiative, nor contribute to The Organiser's profits.
2. The Organiser will receive 25% commission excluding GST from the total sales made during the Fundraising Period.
3. The 25% commission will be paid to The Organiser in the form of a cheque and is only issued in the name of The Organiser and not to an individual.
4. If The Organiser achieves more than \$7,000 in sales during the Fundraising Period, they will be entitled to receive a free St John portable Medium Risk Workplace First Aid Kit, valued at \$145.00.
5. St John cannot guarantee availability of the Medium Risk Workplace First Aid Kit and reserves the right to substitute the kit for one of equal or greater value.
6. The Organiser takes full responsibility for the distribution of Product order forms within their organisation/community and for collection of all orders at the end of the Fundraising Period. All completed order forms must be returned in the registered post pre-paid envelope provided to The Organiser by St John.

Payment Terms

7. St John will accept only credit card payments for purchase of Products as part of the fundraising initiative. No credit card fees apply.
8. Payments will be processed upon St John's receipt of all Product order forms from The Organiser. St John will use reasonable efforts to ensure that payment will occur within 2 days of receiving the orders, and a copy of all orders with attached receipts will be sent to The Organiser with the delivery of stock.
9. St John cannot guarantee that payment transactions will be processed within these timeframes and we will not be liable for any loss, damage or costs incurred by you or any other person as a result of transaction processing delays.

10. St John may refuse to process a payment transaction at any time, or may require additional information from The Organiser before the transaction is processed.
11. No refunds on stock will be given unless goods are damaged or not of merchantable quality.

Delivery Terms

12. St John will cover delivery cost of stock to The Organiser.
13. First aid kit stock will be delivered to The Organiser along with receipts and individual order forms within 1 month of orders being received by St John.
14. St John will not be liable for any loss, damage or misadventure of the posted order forms.
